THE GAP

Families leave with insight. They still need a practical next step.

You do the hard work. Whether that is a psychoeducational assessment, a learning consultation, an ADHD coaching intake, or a gifted education review — you identify what is going on with the child. You explain it clearly. You give the family genuine understanding of their learner.

And then the appointment ends.

Most families leave knowing more about their child than they ever have. Very few leave knowing what to do on Monday morning.

The gap is not in your work. It is in what exists after your work. The resources families are typically handed — apps, worksheets, tutoring referrals, grade-level programs — are built for average learners moving at an average pace. They are not built for the children you see.

What happens to gifted and 2E learners in standard programs

- Gifted learners hit the content ceiling within weeks and disengage
- 2E learners are handed programs that either move too fast or too slow — rarely right
- Uneven learners get placed at their weakest point, not their actual working level
- Advanced goal-driven learners lose time waiting for a curriculum to catch up to them
- Children with gaps who need a fresh start get placed in grade-level content that carries shame from previous failure

None of these children are served by standard solutions. And until now, there has been no adaptive maths pathway purpose-built for them.

WHAT NOVA LEVELS DOES

Adaptive AI maths.

Built to find the real working level and teach from there.

Nova Levels is an adaptive AI maths pathway that begins with a short level check, identifies a child's real working level, and starts instruction from that point.

It does not start at the child's grade. It does not assume the child is behind. It finds where the child actually is — and goes from there.

No grade ceiling

The pathway continues as far as the child can go. A child working three years ahead simply keeps going. The pathway is designed to keep advancing as the child is ready.

Adapts in real time

Lessons adjust based on how the child responds. Faster when ready. More support when needed. No classroom pace to follow.

One-on-one always

Every session is between the AI and one child. No waiting for the class. Full attention, every time.

How a session works

A child opens Nova Levels and completes a short Maths Level Check — typically 10 to 15 minutes. The AI estimates the child's current working level across key maths domains and builds a personalised pathway from that point. Each subsequent session builds on the previous one. Progress is tracked automatically. There is nothing for the parent to configure or manage session by session.

What Nova Levels is not

- It is not a homework help tool or answer-checker
- It is not a grade-level catch-up program
- It is not a replacement for specialist assessment, tutoring, or intervention
- It does not diagnose any learning difference or condition

Nova Levels is an educational learning tool. Its role is maths placement and ongoing adaptive instruction — nothing more and nothing less.

WHO IT IS BUILT FOR

The learners you see most.

These are the learner profiles Nova Levels is designed for. If you work with any of these children regularly, Nova Levels is built for your referrals.

Learner Profile	What this looks like in practice
Gifted but disengaged	Working significantly above grade level. Finishes classwork in minutes. Stopped trying because the curriculum stopped challenging them. Needs content that keeps pace with their ability.
Twice-exceptional (2E)	Gifted in reasoning or maths alongside ADHD, dyslexia, autism, or another learning difference. Schools often see only the challenge, not the ability. Needs both the stretch and the flexibility.
Uneven learner	Strong in some areas, weaker in others. Placed at their lowest level by standard programs. Needs an entry point that honours what they can do while supporting where they need help.
Maths-strong, literacy-challenged	High maths ability but reading or writing challenges mean they underperform on written assessments. Maths instruction does not need to wait for literacy to catch up.
Goal-driven advanced learner	Has a specific goal — engineering, aviation, medicine, competitive academics — that requires advanced maths well before standard school age. Cannot afford to wait for the curriculum.
Gaps and a fresh start	Has missed content, had a difficult school experience, or carries shame around maths. Needs a placement-first approach that meets them without judgement and builds from solid ground.
Rural or under-supported	Limited access to specialist maths tutors or gifted programs due to geography or resources. Nova Levels delivers the same adaptive pathway regardless of location.

HOW REFERRALS WORK

What happens when you refer
